DISEASES OF ANIMALS (FENCING) ORDINANCE 1907.

Definition of a Legal Fence.

In accordance with the Rules and Regulations laid down in section 12 of the above Ordinance and by virtue of the powers conferred on me therein, I declare the following to be Legal Fences within the meaning of the Act.

A Legal Fence is a 4, 5, or 6 strand barbed or plain wire fence 3' 10" high, firmly fixed with strainers, standards and droppers; or a well and substantially built stone wall 4 feet high gates 15 feet wide being erected on all public roads. To be erected according to details given below.

Wire Fence.

- 1. WIRE a $12\frac{1}{2}$ gauge barbed wire, or plain wire, the gauge of which is not less than 8 in iron wire, or a gauge of equivalent strength in steel or galvanised wire, to be used.
 - b Where 4 wires are used, the top wire to be 46 inches, second wire 35 inches, third wire 26 inches and forth wire 18 inches respectively from the ground. If fifth and sixth wires are used, the length to be 11 inches and 5 inches from the ground respectively.
- 2. STRAINERS a To be not less than 7 feet 2 inches in length, and not less than 6 inches in diameter at the small end, or $5\frac{1}{2}$ inches on the square and to stand 3 feet in the ground. To be sufficiently straight in the plane of the fence, to be either bored with a $\frac{3}{4}$ inch bit and all wires run through and tightly strained and fastened to same wire round strainer, with no less than 4 turns round wire, or to have 2 turns round strainer and to be securely fastened with staples.
 - b No strainer to be more than 400 yards apart.
 - c All corner posts to be strainers and fixed with 2 substantial stays or struts; where struts only are used, proper footings to be firmly allotted to corner posts.

- 3. STANDARDS To be not less than 5 feet 6 inches in length, not less than 4 inches in diameter at the small end and to be straight in the plane of the fence. To be 18 inches in the ground, not more than 40 feet apart with at least 4 droppers between and not more than 18 feet apart if no droppers are used.
 - b At abrupt rises in the line, all necessary standards to be securely anchored.
 - c All strainers or standards to have the tops sawn or cut square.
- 4. DROPPERS To be 2 inches in diameter.
- 5. WOOD Wood for strainers, standards or droppers to be either Mohogo, Olive, Cedar, Stinkwood, Greenheart or other wood approved of by the Conservator of Forests.
- 6. GATES a Gates 15 feet wide and 4 feet 6 inches high, to be hung on strong posts erected for the purpose and not on the strainers or corner posts.
 - b All gate posts to be 9 feet high and 8 inches in diameter at the small end. to be 3 feet in the ground and securely anchored and 15 feet 6 inches apart,

Stone Wall.

1. ROUND STONES. Where round stones are employed, the minimum dimensions of a dry stone wall to be

Height, 4 feet. Base, 3 ,, Summit, 2 ,,

2. ROUGHLY SQUARED STONES

Where roughly squared stones are employed, the minimum dimensions of a dry stone wall to be

Height, 4 feet. Base, 2 ,, Summit, 18 inches.

3. GATES a Gates 15 feet wide and 4 feet 6 inches high to be hung on strong posts erected for the purpose.

b All gate posts to be 9 feet high and 8 inches in diameter at the small end, to be 3 feet in the ground and securely anchored and 15 feet 6 inches apart.
