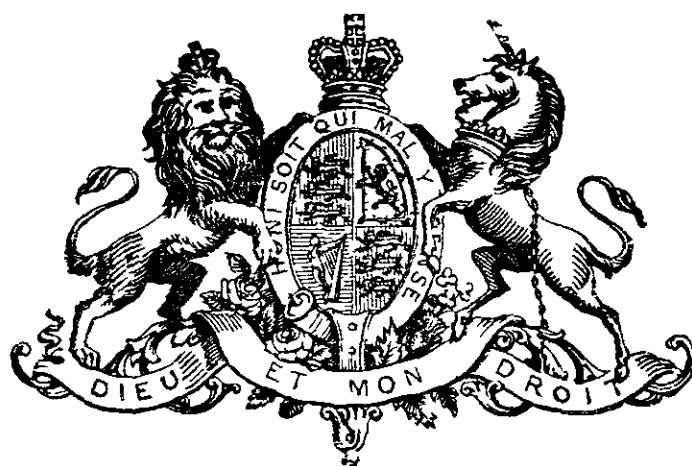

PROCLAMATION No 58]

## THE BRITISH PROTECTORATES (DEFENCE) ORDER-IN-COUNCIL, 1916.

### PROCLAMATION

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred upon the Governor by the British Protectorates (Defence) Order-in-Council, 1916, I, Charles Calvert Bowring, a Companion of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Acting Governor of the East Africa Protectorate, hereby declare that on and after the 15th day of July, 1918, no person shall sell by retail in Nairobi meat of the kinds specified in the first column of the Schedule hereto at prices exceeding the amounts set out opposite thereto respectively in the second column of the said Schedule

Any person contravening the provisions of this Proclamation is guilty of an offence against the British Protectorates (Defence) Order-in-Council, 1916, Article V, Clause 8, and is liable to a fine not exceeding Rs 75/- or to a term of imprisonment not exceeding 3 months

**NAIROBI MILITARY AREA.**

THE following are the boundaries of the Military Area, Nairobi —

**NORTH** —From corner of Chamberlain and Upper Hill Road by King's African Rifles Headquarters, along Chamberlain Road, thence along Gymkhana Road to N'Gong Road to Girouard Road, thence as far as the New King's African Rifles Home. Then a line from the King's African Rifles Home through the Waterworks to the corner of Hurlingham Road in which M. Graham Dawson's house is situated, thence a line to meet the N'Gong Road at the bridge below the Golf Links, thence along the N'Gong Road to red and black stake Beacon about 100 yards short of Dagoretti Crossing

**WEST** —From on the N'Gong Road about 10 yards from Dagoretti Cross Roads due South to meet the M'Bagathi Tramway

**SOUTH** —M'Bagathi Tramway. A point marked with black and red stake

**EAST** —Corner of Chamberlain Road by King's African Rifles Headquarters along Upper Hill Road to where it bends to East and from thence due South to the M'Bagathi Tramway

**NOTE** —The compounds of all civilians in this area and also the actual N'Gong and Hurlingham Roads are exempt

Any such licensed Coffee must be registered with the Chief of Customs, Mombasa, in the usual manner

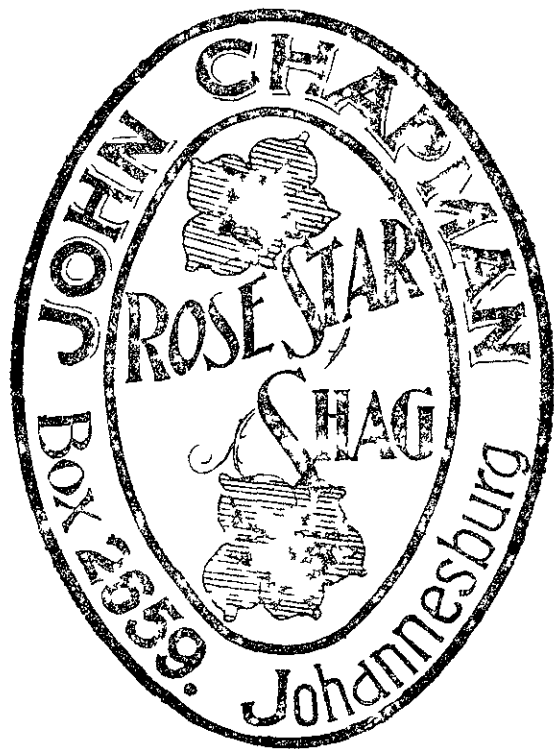
