THE LAND ACQUISITION ACT, 1894

DECLARATION UNDER SECTION 6

IT IS hereby notified and declared that two portions of land, being strips one hundred and twenty feet wide, one extending from Makupa Causeway to Changamwe ridge containing approximately 19.3 acres, and the other from the railway beyond Kwa Jomvu Station to the North Nyika Native Land Unit beyond Mazeras, containing approximately 99 acres, are required for a public road. The portions of land are bounded by lines on each side of, and distant 60 feet from, a centre line marked on the ground with pegs and trenches and with a red line on Plan No. 34524 II/2, copies of which may be inspected at the office of the Mombasa branch of the Lands, Mines and Surveys Department or at the office of the District Commissioner, Mombasa. VACANCIES IN UGANDA PROTECTORATE

Two Asian Sub-Inspectors of Police

APPLICATIONS are invited for the post of Asian Sub-Inspector of Police for which there are two vacancies.

Applicants must be not less than 21 years or more than 25 years of age; senior secondary school certificate; be of good physique, being not less than 5 ft. 7 in. in height and 36 in. in chest measurement; preferably unmarried, and speaking Swahili.

Conditions of service: Selected candidates will undergo a six- to eight-months' course at the Police Training School, Kampala, during which they receive Sh. 200 per month. On passing out they will be appointed 2nd Grade Assistant Sub-Inspectors at Sh. 250 per month; on completion of three years' service they will be eligible for advancement to 1st Grade A.S.I. at Sh. 300 per month, provided they have passed the prescribed examinations; on completion of a further three years' service they will be eligible for advancement to 2nd Grade Sub-Inspectors at Sh. 350 per month. Thereafter, "according to vacancies, they are eligible for promotion to 1st Grade Sub-Inspector on a salary of Sh. 380-20-510.

Cost of living allowances at rates as prescribed for other Government employees are payable; rations or ration allowances are not granted.

Other conditions of service (leave, transport privileges, etc.) are in accordance with the terms laid down for members of the Local Civil Service, Uganda.

IT IS hereby notified for general information that after full consideration it has been decided not to renew the Uganda Government's guarantee to the importers and the Uganda Piece Goods Buying Pool. The Government's guarantee expired, therefore, on 31st October, 1947, in accordance with the terms of paragraph 1 of General Notice No. 197 of 1947.

After consultation with the Piece Goods Buying Pool it has, however, been agreed that the Pool shall continue to function as from 1st November, 1947, and until further notice, but shall from that date operate within certain limitations detailed below. It should be noted, however, that it is the intention that U.S.A. cotton piece goods shall be decontrolled as from some date in the near future to be determined when stocks of these goods in the hands of the Piece Goods Buying Pool have been distributed.

Henceforth, the Pool will receive allocations from importations on the basis of country of origin, and in accordance with the following classes of cotton piece goods:—

- (a) *India*.—All classes of cotton piece goods (excluding blankets) excepting those types on the prohibited list.
- (b) *United Kingdom*.—(i) Prints, bleached calico, khaki drill, greys and coloured piece goods, and other classes of goods dyed in the piece; (ii) when necessary, such cotton piece goods as may be processed in the United Kingdom from grey cloth imported into the United Kingdom.
- (c) Such other goods from any sources which at the discretion of the Imports Controller, Kenya and Uganda, may from time to time be considered as necessary for inter-territorial (Kenya/Uganda) distribution.

It should be noted that the expiration of the Uganda Government's guarantee to the importers of which reference is made in paragraph 1, is subject to the restitution of the old "F" profit margin from the date of withdrawal of the Government's undertaking.

As soon as practicable, notice will be given of the date from which it is intended to give effect to the proposal to decontrol U.S.A. cotton piece goods. Until that date Uganda will not be regarded as a free market for goods from that source. Cotton piece goods from sources other than India and the United Kingdom as above specified are automatically decontrolled with effect from 1st November, 1947.
