#### LEGAL NOTICE

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred upon the Council of Ministers by Articles 12(3) and 36 of the Protocol on the Establishment of the EAC Customs Union and Section 140 of the East African Community Customs Management Act 2004, the Council of Ministers has extended the application of Legal Notice No. EAC/10/2007 of 18th June 2007 for the gazetted manufacturers to import the specified raw materials and industrial inputs free of duty under the duty remission scheme for one year.

The remission of duty is deemed to have come into effect on 1st July 2010 and shall expire on 30th June 2011.
