IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred upon the Council of Ministers by Articles 12 (3) and 39(c) of the Protocol on the Establishment of the East African Community Customs Union, the Council of Ministers has approved the stay of application of the Common External Tariff on 40,000MT of sugar falling under tariff Codes 1701.11.90; 1701.12.90; 1701.91.00; and 1701.99.90 imported by the United Republic of Tanzania and shall apply a duty rate of 0% for a period up to 30th June, 2011

This notice shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of January 2011.
