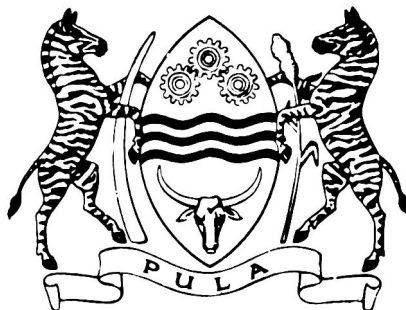

Assizing – Chobe District, Eastern Ngamiland District, Nata and Mosetse

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN under the provisions of section 17 (1) of the Weights and Measures Act that all persons having weighing or measuring instruments, weights or measures in use in trade or in their possession or charge for use in trade, within the area specified in the Schedule, are required to produce the same to an assizer for the purpose of their being assized or re-assized at their trade premises during the period specified when called upon so to do by an assizer.
