BANK OF BOTSWANA ACT
(Cap. 74:07)

Bank of Botswana - Maintenance of Primary Reserves

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 38 of the Bank of Botswana Act, the Bank of Botswana requires every financial institution to maintain, with effect from 26th July, 1977, primary reserves of not less than —

(a) 6% of demand deposit liabilities, including money on call; and

(b) 3% of time, notice and savings deposit liabilities.

2. For the purposes of calculating the reserves required to be maintained, —

(a) the deposit liabilities referred to above shall be the average of the previous month's mid-month and end-month liabilities;

(b) new reserve requirements shall come into effect on the 26th day of the month after the month referred to in subparagraph (a); and

(c) Government deposits shall be included in the definition of deposit liabilities.

3. (1) Each financial institution shall submit a monthly statement of its deposit liabilities to the Bank in sufficient detail to enable the reserve requirements to be calculated by the Bank.

(2) The said monthly statement must be delivered to the Bank within 21 days of the end of the month referred to.

(3) In the event that the monthly statement is not delivered to the Bank on time, the Bank shall deem the primary reserve requirements of the offending financial institution to be 125% of the previous month's requirement.

except such persons who have been advised in writing by the Commissioner that a return is not required for the tax year.

**HOUSE OF CHIEFS (SALARIES AND ALLOWANCES)
(AMENDMENT) BILL, 1977**

(Published on 24th June, 1977)

MEMORANDUM

A draft of the above Bill, which it is proposed to present to the National Assembly, is set out below.

2. The object of the Bill is to amend the House of Chiefs (Salaries and Allowances) Act in order to increase the salaries of the Chairman and Members of the House of Chiefs and their subsistence and motor vehicle transport allowances, with effect from 1st July, 1976.

3. These salaries and allowances have remained unchanged since late 1974 when the House of Chiefs (Salaries and Allowances) (Amendment) Act, 1974, (No. 17 of 1974) came into operation.

4. The Bill increases —

- (a) the annual salary of the Chairman of the House of Chiefs from P720 to P864;
- (b) the annual salary of each Member of the House of Chiefs from P600 to P720;
- (c) the Chairman's and Members' daily subsistence allowance from P15 to P20; and
- (d) the Chairman's and Members' motor vehicle transport allowance from 10 thebe to 15 thebe per km.

MARRIAGE (AMENDMENT) BILL, 1977

(Published on 24th June, 1977)

MEMORANDUM

A draft of the above Bill, which it is proposed to present to the National Assembly, is set out below.

2. The object of the Bill is to amend the Marriage Proclamation (Cap. 144 of the 1959 edition of the Laws) in order to put it beyond doubt that —

- (a) a substituting marriage under the Proclamation is a bar to any subsequent customary law marriage;
- (b) a subsisting customary law marriage is a bar to any subsequent marriage contracted under the Proclamation; and
- (c) entry into such a subsequent marriage constitutes, in either case, bigamy.

3. The amendments to be effected by the Bill will ensure that the Proclamation gives clear and unambiguous effect to the concept of monogamous marriage.

- (b) in paragraph (c) thereof, by inserting, immediately after the words "another marriage", which appear therein, the words "whether that other marriage is contracted under this Proclamation or in accordance with any customary law,".

3. Section 15 of the principal Act is amended by substituting for subsection (1) thereof the new subsections following —

Provided that such a person may contract a marriage in accordance with any customary law with the person with whom the previous marriage was contracted.

(1A) No person who has previously contracted a marriage in accordance with any customary law with a person still living may contract a marriage under this Proclamation unless the previous marriage has been dissolved or annulled in accordance with the applicable law, whether customary or otherwise:

Provided that such a person may contract a marriage under this Proclamation with the person with whom the previous marriage was contracted.

(1B) Where a person purports to contract a marriage under this Proclamation or in accordance with any customary law which he is prohibited from so contracting by subsection (1) or (1A), the ceremony of marriage shall be void.”.
