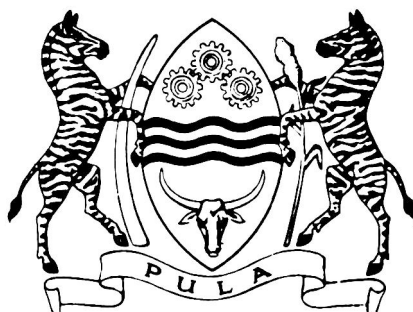

Notice of Issue of Election Instruments

IN ACCORDANCE with regulation 5 (5) of the Local Councils (Conduct of Elections) Regulations, the Local Government Election Supervisor hereby gives notice that the Minister of Local Government and Lands has issued an election instrument addressed to the returning officer of each of the polling districts specified in the first column of the Schedule directing —

- (a) the returning officer to receive nominations of candidates at the polling district headquarters specified in the corresponding entry in the second column of the Schedule between 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. on 15th July, 1977; and
- (b) that any poll which may become necessary shall be taken on 6th August, 1977.

CHIEFTAINSHIP (AMENDMENT) BILL, 1977

(Published on 8th July, 1977)

MEMORANDUM

A draft of the above Bill, which it is proposed to present to the National Assembly, is set out below.

2. The object of the Bill is to amend the Chieftainship Act (Cap. 41:01) to enable the President to recognize as Chief a person so designated who is, for any reason, temporarily unable to assume the powers and duties of the chieftainship, and, in such a case, appoint a tribal authority, who shall hold office until the Chief is able to assume the powers and duties of the chieftainship.

ENACTED by the Parliament of Botswana.

1. This Act may be cited as the Chieftainship (Amendment) Act, 1977. Short title

2. Section 2 of the Chieftainship Act (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act") is amended by substituting for the words "section 9", which appear in the definition of "tribal authority", the words "section 6 (1A) or 9". Amendment of section 2 of Cap. 41:01

3. Section 6 of the principal Act is amended by inserting, immediately after subsection (1) thereof, the new subsection following — Amendment of section 6 of principal Act

“(1A) If the President considers that a person designated as Chief is, for any reason, unable to assume the chieftainship, he may recognize the person so designated as Chief but may appoint a tribal authority who shall hold office as such until the President considers the Chief is able to assume the chieftainship.”.
