

Applications for Government of Botswana Treasury Bills

The Minister of Finance and Development Planning hereby gives notice that applications will be received at the Bank of Botswana, Khama Crescent, Gaborone, on Thursday, 18th August, 1977, at 12 noon, for Treasury Bills to be issued under the Stock, Bonds and Treasury Bills Act, 1976, and in accordance with the Treasury Bills Regulations, 1976, to the amount of P1 000 000.

2. The price per cent at which the Bills will be offered will be published by the Bank of Botswana not later than 9 a.m. on Thursday, 18th August, 1977.

Declaration of Infected Area – Mahalapye
