WEIGHTS AND MEASURES ACT

(Cap. 43:06)

Assizing - Selebi-Phikwe

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN under the provisions of section 17 (1) of the Weights and Measures Act that all persons having weighing and measuring instruments, weights or measures in use in trade or in their possession or charge for use in trade, within the area specified in the Schedule, are required to produce the same to an assizer for the purpose of their being assized or re-assized at the place and at the appropriate time specified in the Schedule.

A person having, within the area specified in an instrument or measure which —

- (i) is fixed;
- (ii) has a weighing capacity exceeding 272 kg;
