#### COMPANIES ACT (Cap. 42:01)

## **Overpayment of Penalties**

DUE to inadvertence a number of companies were, during the period 1st April, 1974, to 1st August, 1977, charged excess fees or penalties in respect of the submission of various forms and returns made to the Registrar of Companies. This arose as it was mistakenly believed that the revised Seventh Schedule substituted by Statutory Instrument No. 13 of 1974 and amended by Statutory No. 19 of 1975 had retrospective effect. This was not so. Furthermore, penalties were also inadvertently charged for the non- or late submission of the certificate under section 96 (4) of the Act in the mistaken belief that such certificate formed part of the annual return required of each company.

Any company which considers it may have paid excess fees or penalties is invited to submit detailed particulars to the Registrar of Companies, whereupon any excess paid will be refunded.

UPON HEARING Mr Attorney Kades for the Petitioner, having read the documents as filed on record and heard evidence ---

- IT IS ORDERED:
- 1. That the Respondent company be and is hereby placed provisionally under judicial management in terms of Section 265 of the Companies Proclation Chapter 42:01.
- 2. That while this order is in force the company be under the management, subject to the supervision of the court of a provisional judicial manager or managers appointed by the Master.
- 3. That as from this date any other person or persons vested with the management of the company's alfairs be divested thereof.

4. That the provisional manager or managers discharge the duties prescribed by Section 268 of the Companies Proclamation Chapter 42:01.

- 5. That the provisional judicial manager or managers appointed by the Master be empowered without the authority of the shareholders but subject to the authority of creditors and the Master to borrow moneys with or without security on behalf of the said company for the purpose of paying essential running expenditure in and about the business of the said company, including salaries, wages and rental for business premises required by the said company and to pledge the credit of the said company for any goods or services required.
- 6. That while the company is under judicial management all actions, proceedings, the execution of all writs, summonses and other processes against the company be stayed and be not proceeded with without the leave of this court being had an obtained.
- 7. That the rate of remuneration of the provisional judicial manager or managers be fixed by the Master in accordance with the services rendered and disbursements incurred, or should the Master so request the said rate of remuneration shall be fixed by the court after the Master has reported thereon.

    - (i) That the management of the company shall vest subject to the supervision of the court in the final judicial manager or managers;
    - (ii) That the provisional judicial manager or managers shall forthwith hand over all matters and account for his or their administration of the property, business and affairs of the company to the final judicial manager or managers;
    - (iii) That the provisional judicial manager or managers be discharged from their duties, but that he or they remain obliged to account to the final judicial manager or managers as aforesaid and to the Master;
    - (iv) That the provisions of paragraphs 5 to 9 should apply mutatis mutandis;
    - (v) That the final judicial manager or managers discharge the duties prescribed by Section 268 of the Companies Proclamation Chapter 42:01.
  - (c) And why the costs of this application should not be costs in the judicial management.
