Applications for Government of Botswana Treasury Bills

The Minister of Finance and Development Planning hereby gives notice that applications will be received at the Bank of Botswana, Khama Crescent, Gaborone on Thursday, 25th May, 1978, at 12 noon, for Treasury Bills to be issued under the Stock, Bonds and Treasury Bills Act, 1976, and in accordance with the Treasury Bills Regulations, 1976, to the amount of P1 000 000.

- 2. The price per cent at which the Bills will be offered will be published by the Bank of Botswana not later than 9 a.m. on Thursday, 25th May, 1978.
- 3. The Bills will be in amount of P1 000 or a multiple of P1 000. They will be dated 26th May, 1978 and will be due 91 days after date.
 - 4. The Bills will be issued and paid at the Bank of Botswana.
 - 5. Each application must be for a minimum of P1 000.
 - 6. Applications must be made through a commercial bank in Botswana,
- 7. Notification will be sent, on the same day as applications are received, to the persons whose applications are accepted in whole or in part.
- 8. Payment in full of the amount due in respect of such accepted applications must be made to the Bank of Botswana by means of cash or by draft or cheque drawn on the Bank of Botswana not later than noon on the day on which the relative Bills are to be dated.
- 9. Applications must be made on the official printed forms which may be obtained from the commercial banks or the Accounts and Banking Office, Bank of Botswana.
- 10. The Minister of Finance and Development Planning reserves the right to reject any application in whole or in part.

FARM MANAGEMENT CENTRE - RAMATLABAMA

Tenders are invited for the construction and completion of the Farm Management Centre at Ramatlabama comprising a Dormitory and Ablution Block (plinth area 185 m² excluding verandahs), Kitchen and Common Room Block (plinth area approximately 165 m²), Generator House and alterations to the existing Farm Centre together with associated external works and services. All buildings are of conventional single storey construction.

Tender documents will be available from 5th June, 1978 on application to the Chief Architect, Buildings Department, Private Bag 0025, Gaborone (Room 215, Ministry of Works and Communications).

Tenders shall be delivered to the Secretary, Central Tender Board, Private Bag 0058, Gaborone (Room 306, Ministry of Finance and Development Planning) not later than 09.00 hours on Wednesday 5th July, 1978 when they will be opened in the presence of tenderers wishing to attend. Tenders shall be delivered in the envelope provided. Telegraphic, telex and telephonic tenders or tenders delivered after the above time and date will not be considered.

Drawings may be inspected by appointment only at the offices of the Buildings Department.

Tenders will only be considered from Contractors registered with Central Tender Board in building Class Grade A or above at the date for submission of tenders, or from such Contractors who can provide satisfactory proof of intention to apply for such registration by the mentioned date provided always that if the application defined above is not accepted the tender will not be considered for acceptance.

This project is financed by the European Development Fund and the choice of Contractor is subject to E.D.F. approval. Contractors shall be registered companies —

1. established in accordance with the law of an E.E.C. state or an A.C.P. state (signatories to the Lome Convention) and whose registered office, Central Administration or principal place of business is in an E.E.C. state or A.C.P. state; or

2. whose principal place of business is not in an E.E.C. state or A.C.P. state but who maintain a continuous presence in Botswana engaged in an effective and continuous link with the economy of Botswana.
