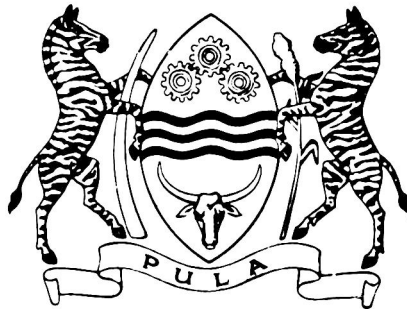

MEMORANDUM

A draft of the above Bill, which it is proposed to present to the National Assembly, is set out below.

2. Section 32 of the Building Societies Act (Cap. 42:02) provides that the sum total of all advances on each of which there is owing to a building society an aggregate amount in excess of P10 000 shall at no time exceed the percentage set out in the second column of the Third Schedule in relation in each case to the total assets of the society as severally set out in the first column of the First Schedule.

3. The first object of the Bill is to correct the erroneous reference in section 32 to the first column of the First Schedule to the Building Societies Act. The reference should be to the first column of the Third Schedule to that Act.

4. The second and principal object of the Bill is to amend section 32 in order to give the Minister the power, by order published in the Gazette, to amend the Third Schedule to the Building Societies Act.
