# WATER UTILITIES CORPORATION (AMENDMENT) BILL, 1978

(Published on 11th August, 1978)

MEMORANDUM

A draft of the above Bill, which it is proposed to present to the National Assembly, is set out below.

2. While section 15 of the Water Utilities Corporation Act (Cap. 74:02) gives wide powers to the Water Utilities Corporation to dispose of its property, it forbids the Corporation to dispose of any property to a member, officer or employee of the Corporation or to any agent or contractor appointed or employed by the Corporation.

3. Section 15 thus effectively prevents the Corporation from selling staff houses to employees of the Corporation who may wish to buy them.

4. The object of the Bill is to amend section 15 of the Water Utilities Corporation Act in order to give the Corporation a limited power to sell staff houses to pensionable employees of the Corporation who are citizens of Botswana.
