HYPOTHECATION (AMENDMENT) AND CONSEQUENTIAL AMENDMENT BILL, 1978

(Published on 18th August, 1978)

MEMORANDUM

A draft of the above Bill, which it is proposed to present to the National Assembly, is set out below.

2. Section 3(2)(b) of the Hypothecation Act, 1977, (No. 40 of 1977), provides that a document evidencing a hypothecation entered into under section 3 shall be lodged by the authorized creditor, together with the prescribed fee, with the Registrar of Deeds within 30 days of its execution and shall be registered by him in the manner of a notarial deed.

3. The principal purpose of the Bill is to amend section 3 (2) (b) of the Hypothecation Act, 1977, to remove the requirement that the Registrar of Deeds register such a document in the manner of a notarial bond.

4. Doubts have been expressed as to the precise meaning of the requirement and it is considered that the best course to resolve those doubts is to remove the requirement.

5. To avoid any possibility of conflict, the Bill also proposes to amend section 5 (1) of the Agricultural Charges Act (Cap. 35:01).

6. Section 5 (1) of the Agricultural Charges Act provides that a copy of a certificate of indebtedness, such as is referred to in section 4 of the Act, shall be lodged by the National Development Bank with the Registrar of Deeds within 30 days of the signature and shall be registered by him in the manner of a notarial bond.

7. The Bill proposes to amend section 5(1) of the Agricultural Charges Act to remove the requirement that the Registrar of Deeds register such a certificate of indebtedness in the manner of a notarial bond.
