CONSTITUTION OF BOTSWANA

Authorization of Vice-President to Discharge Functions of the President

To:

THE HONOURABLE QUETT KETUMILE JONNY MASIRE. M.P., VICE-PRESIDENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF BOTSWANA

WHEREAS it is provided in section 36 (1) of the Constitution of Botswana that whenever the President is absent from Botswana or considers it desirable so to do by reason of illness or any other cause he may, by directions in writing, authorize the Vice-President to discharge such of the functions of the office of President as he may specify and the Vice-President may discharge those functions until his authority is revoked by the President;

AND WHEREAS I intend to be absent from Botswana from 30th July, 1979, and consider it desirable to issue directions as aforesaid:

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested in me as aforesaid, I authorize you, the said Quett Ketumile Jonny Masire, in your capacity as Vice-President, to discharge, with effect from the said 30th July, 1979, all the functions of the office of President, except –

- (a) the power to dissolve Parliament in accordance with the provisions of section 91 of the Constitution;
- (b) the power to appoint persons to the office of Minister or Assistant Minister in accordance with the provisions of section 42 of the Constitution:

Provided, however, that you can appoint the present Ministers or Assistant Ministers to act-in place of any Minister who is otherwise not available:

(c) the power to remove a Minister or Assistant Minister from office in accordance with the provisions of section 43 of the Constitution.

until this, my authority, is revoked by me.

The amendment of section 5 of the Presidential Elections (Supplementary Provisions) Act (Cap. 02:01) by the Presidential Elections (Supplementary Provisions) (Amendment) Act, 1977 (No. 14 of 1977), necessitates an amendment to be made to some of the forms in the Schedule for the purpose of giving effect to the section as amended. This Bill is intended to amend the Act by giving power to the Supervisor of Elections to amend the forms in the Schedule or to prescribe new ones if it is considered necessary for the purpose of giving effect to the provisions of the Act.
