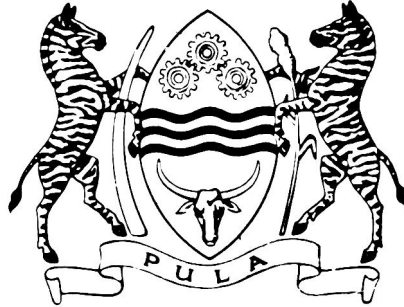

BRITISH SOUTH AFRICA COMPANY LAND (AMENDMENT) BILL, 1979

(Published on 10th August, 1979)

MEMORANDUM

A draft of the above Bill, which it is proposed to present to the National Assembly, is set out below.

2. Under the existing provisions of section 5 of the British South Africa Company Land Act (Cap. 32:06) all roads and thoroughfares existing at 7th February, 1905, over Gaborone Block, Lobatse Block and the Tuli Block are to remain free and uninterrupted. Some of these roads or thoroughfares are unauthorized entry points into or out of Botswana. In other words, aliens can use some of these entry points to enter the country without complying with our immigration laws. The main object of the Bill, therefore, is to amend section 5 of the British South Africa Company Land Act by bringing it in line with the Immigration Act (Cap. 25:04) so far as it relates to aliens entering or leaving the country.

1. This Act may be cited as the British South Africa Company Land (Amendment) Act, 1979. Short title

2. The British South Africa Company Land Act is hereby amended by substituting for section 5 thereof the following new section — Substitution of section 5 of Cap. 32:06

“Closure of existing roads and thoroughfares 5. (1) Subject to the provisions of this section, all roads and thoroughfares existing at or after 7th February, 1905, over the lands referred to in section 2 are hereby closed.

(2) No person shall use any of those roads or thoroughfares over the lands referred to in subsection (1) —

- (a) as a means of passage from one farm to the other on such lands; or
- (b) as a point of entry into or out of Botswana unless such road or thoroughfare has been specified under section 4 of the Immigration Act as a point of entry.

(3) Any person who contravenes the provisions of this section shall be guilty of an offence and on conviction thereof shall be liable to the penalties prescribed by section 29 (2) of the Immigration Act.”.
