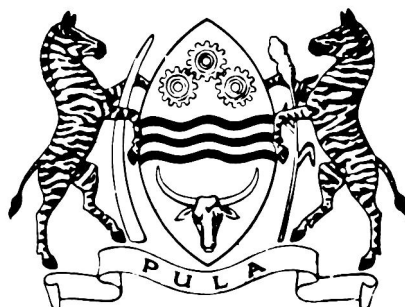

### Applications for Government of Botswana Treasury Bills

The Minister of Finance and Development Planning hereby gives notice that applications will be received at the Bank of Botswana, Khama Crescent, Gaborone, on Thursday, 10th January, 1980, at 12 noon, for Treasury Bills to be issued under the Stock, Bonds and Treasury Bills Act and in accordance with the Treasury Bills Regulations to the amount of P1 000 000.
