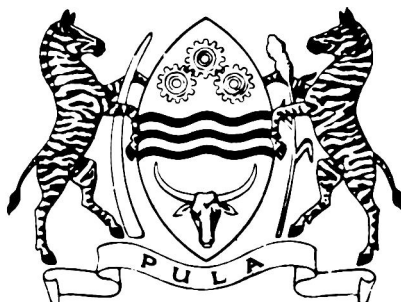

Proposed Extension of the Boundary of the Chobe National Park

IN ACCORDANCE with the provisions of section 3 (4) of the National Parks Act, notice is hereby given that it is proposed to recommend to the President to issue an order to amend the boundary of the Chobe National Park by substituting for the existing boundary the new boundary set out in the Schedule.

2. Any person who wishes to object to the proposed order shall lodge in writing with the Minister, within 30 days of the publication of this notice, the grounds of his objection.

SCHEDULE

CHOBÉ NATIONAL PARK BOUNDARY
