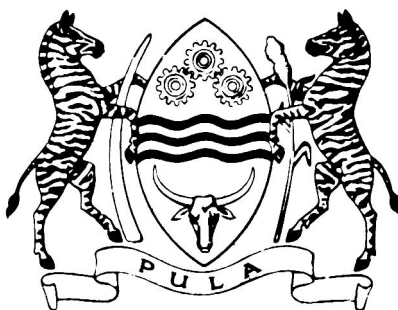

BOTSWANA DEFENCE FORCE (AMENDMENT) BILL, 1980
(Published on 2nd May, 1980)

MEMORANDUM

A draft of the above Bill, which it is proposed to present to the National Assembly, is set out below.

2. Under the existing provisions of section 116 of the Botswana Defence Force Act, 1977, (13 of 1977), exclusive jurisdiction, in relation to certain offences specified in subsections (4) and (5), has been conferred on the military authorities. It is now realised that, due to lack of facilities or personnel, the military authorities are unable adequately to exercise jurisdiction over many of these offences.

3. The main object of the Bill is therefore to amend section 116 to empower the Commander of the Botswana Defence Force to refer to the Attorney-General, who may deal with it in the normal way, any case with which the Commander considers the military authorities are, due to the above-mentioned reasons, not competent to deal.
