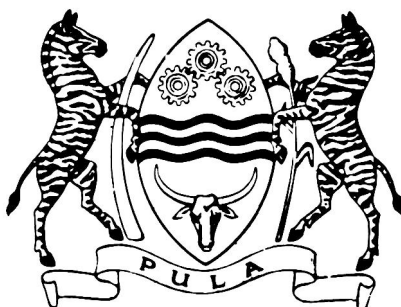

- Urban Migrants' Histories and Patterns of Temporary Migration
- The Influence of Education on Migration
- Impact of Migration on Family Structure
