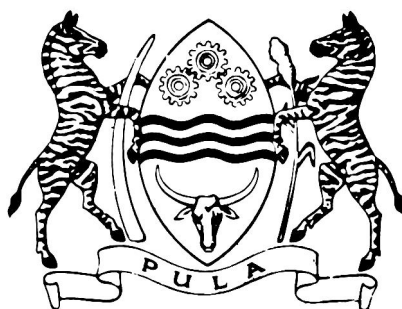

- (4) "Articulated vehicle" means a single operative motor vehicle consisting of a power unit (tractor) coupled with any partly bearing a detachable goods or passenger carrying unit or combination thereof having no front axle (semi-trailer). Each unit of an articulated vehicle is rated as insured separately in respect of the tractor unit under group reference 8, and in respect of the semi-trailer unit according to the purpose for which such unit is designed or used, i.e. under group reference 2A, 2B, 2C, 2D, 3A, 3B, 3C or 3D, as the case may be.
- (5) Station wagons and similar type vehicles, if used for the carrying of trade goods, must be rated under group reference 2A, 2B or 2C.
