FAUNA CONSERVATION ACT (Cap. 38:01)

FAUNA CONSERVATION (UNIFIED HUNTING) REGULATIONS, 1979 (S.I. 19 of 1979)

Determination of Chief Game Warden — Citizens, Residents and Non-Residents (Controlled Hunting Areas and Other Lands)

IN PERFORMANCE of the duty imposed by regulation 16 (1) of the Fauna Conservation (Unified Hunting) Regulations, 1979, the Chief Game Warden, after consultation with the relevant local authorities and land boards, has determined that the number of animals which may be hunted during the year 1981 by citizens, residents and non-residents respectively, in each of the controlled hunting areas or other areas of land, which are specified by the area number and name-place in the first and second columns respectively of Parts I, II and III of the Schedule, of the species named in the other columns of those Parts, shall be the number specified in the appropriate column in relation to that area and species.
