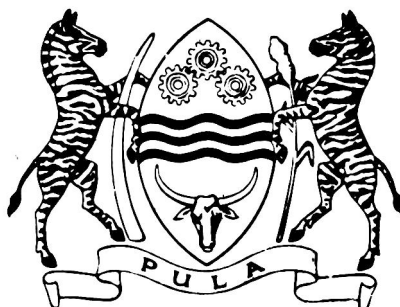

**PRECIOUS AND SEMI-PRECIOUS STONES (PROTECTION)
(AMENDMENT) BILL, 1981**

(Published on 12th June, 1981)

MEMORANDUM

A draft of the above Bill, which it is proposed to present to the National Assembly, is set out below.

2. A recent decision of the High Court has cast considerable doubt on the degree of knowledge to be imputed by a trial court to an accused person charged with unlawful dealing in or possession of rough or uncut precious stones.

3. The principal object of the Bill, therefore, is to amend the Precious and Semi-Precious Stones (Protection) Act (Cap. 66:03) to make it clear that, in any proceedings for unlawful dealing in or possession of rough or uncut precious stones, it is for the accused person to prove, on the balance of probabilities, that he did not know that the stones in question were rough or uncut precious stones.

4. At the same time, the Bill proposes, by substituting a wholly new section 22 of the principal Act, to clarify the meaning of the present section in respect of the burden of proof generally in proceedings for unlawful dealing in or possession of rough or uncut precious stones.

 - (c) that any person accused in the proceedings was not at any material time, licensed, authorized or otherwise entitled by or under this Act to buy, deal in, receive by way of barter, pledge or otherwise, sell, offer or expose for sale, barter, pledge or otherwise, dispose of or deliver for the purpose of trade or have in his possession rough or uncut precious stones or any particular rough or uncut precious stone,
- unless the contrary is proved."
