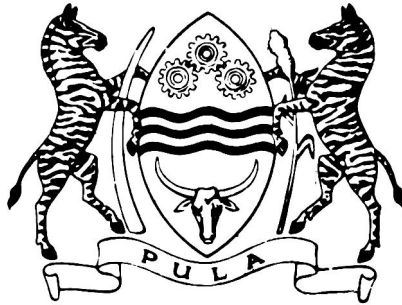

**CONSULTANT ON LAND TENURE NGAMILAND COMMUNAL FIRST DEVELOPMENT AREA**  
A CONSULTANT IS required for five weeks in order to provide input to the land tenure aspects of the land-use planning exercise for the Communal First Development Area. His tasks will be the following:-

- (a) design a household questionnaire concerning land tenure issues for implementation by the land-use planning consultants in preselected priority areas of the CFDA;
- (b) identify issues pertaining to land tenure which should be investigated as part of the longer term research and monitoring programme in the CFDA, in the light of the District proposals for agricultural development in the area; and recommend methods of carrying out such research and monitoring;
- (c) evaluate the Pilot Land Inventory programme as currently implemented in the light of its aims of solving or reducing land tenure problems and allocation conflicts in the CFDA Molapo area;
- (d) prepare guidelines for the District Planner on the following issues:-
  - (i) The method of obtention of arable land by Molapo and dryland farming households in selected areas of the CFDA;
  - (ii) How sanctions concerning the use of arable land are administered at community level.
  - (iii) How or whether rulings on arable allocations subordinate Land Board are enforced.
  - (iv) The implications of the above questions for the development projects proposed for the area.

The Consultant will be a qualified social anthropologist with extensive fieldwork experience in the examination of land tenure issues.

The Consultant will report to the CFDA working group, a sub-committee of LUPAG, in the first instance, and will report in writing to the full LUPAG, at the end of his work. It is expected that he will spend two of the five weeks in the District Headquarters in Maun working with district officials, and be based for the most of the remaining weeks in Gomare working with the subordinate Subordinate Land Board and District Agricultural Officer. He will also liaise with the Applied Research Unit, Local Government and Lands, which will have an officer in Maun for part of the time of the consultancy.

The scheduling will be August/September, 1981.

Transport will be provided by Tawana Land Board or District Administration, Maun. The latter will provide secretarial support.
