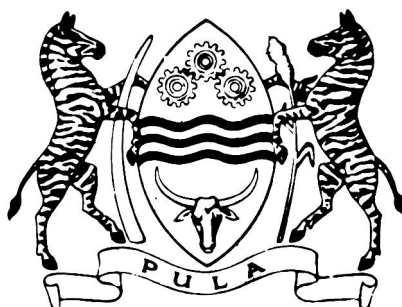

WHEREAS the Government, BCL and BRST on March 5, 1970 entered into an Agreement relating to certain tax matters which was subsequently amended by an Agreement dated June 22, 1971, between the said parties and by an Agreement March 1, 1972, between the said parties and BCL (SALES) and by an Agreement dated March 15, 1978 among the Government, BCL, BRST and BCL (SALES) which Agreement, as so amended, is hereinafter called "the principal Agreement".

AND WHEREAS the Government, BCL, BRST and BCL (SALES) desire further to amend the principal Agreement the better to express their common intentions,
