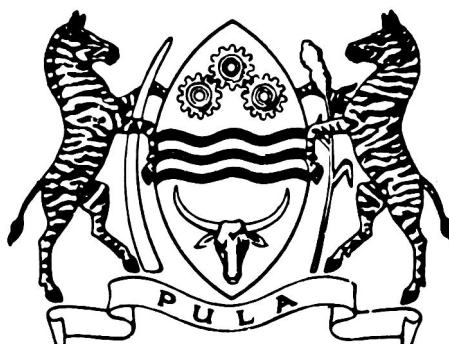

**Determination of Chief Game Warden —
