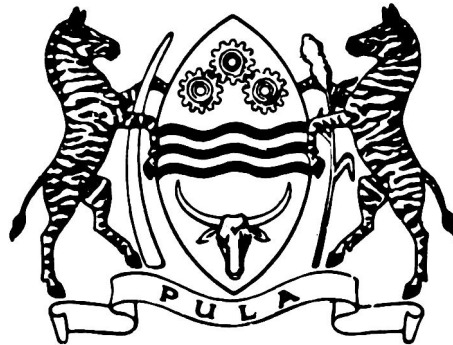

**WEIGHT AND MEASURES ACT**  
(Cap. 43:06)

**Assizing — Selebi-Phikwe**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the Weights and Measures Act, that all persons having weighing or measuring instruments, weights or measures in use in trade or in their possession or charge for use in trade, within the area specified in the Schedule, are required to produce the same to an assizer for the purpose of their being assized or re-assized at their trade premises during the period specified when called upon to do so by an assizer.

Statutory fees will be charged for assizing or re-assizing all equipment and must be paid at the time the equipment is submitted.

It is an offence not to submit equipment for assize or re-assize, or to use in trade equipment that has not been assized, and upon conviction a fine of P100 may be imposed.
