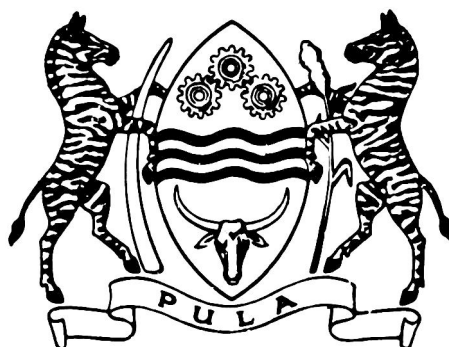

THE CENTRAL DISTRICT COUNCIL has through the Government of the Republic of Botswana received, from the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development (World Bank), financial assistance for the construction of primary school facilities at the village of Letlhakane.

The Central District Council invites interested contractors to submit information for prequalification purposes in connection with the above mentioned project. The construction work for the project will be awarded by international competitive bidding according to the requirement of the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development.

(a) in the case of a first offence, to a fine of P250 and in default of payment of such fine, to a term of imprisonment for 12 months;

(b) in the case of second or subsequent offence, to a fine of P1000 and in default of payment of such fine, to a term of imprisonment for 2 years.
