- 1. This Act may be cited as the Waterworks (Amendment) Act, Short title 1983.
- 2. Section 22 of the Waterworks Act (in this Act referred to as "the principal Act") is hereby amended by substituting for the words "a fine of P10" wherever they appear in the section the words "a fine of P250".

3. Section 25 of the principal Act is hereby amended by substituting for that section the following new section —

"Water than for purpose supplied"

- (1) Any person who uses any water supplied to him used other by the Water Authority for purposes other than those for which the water is supplied or for purposes in contravention of any prohibition specified under section 16 shall be guilty of an offence and liable —
 - (a) in the case of a first offence, to a fine of P250 and in default of payment of such fine, to a term of imprisonment for 12 months:
 - (b) in the case of second or subsequent offence, to a fine of P1000 and in default of payment of such fine, to a term of imprisonment for 2 years.
