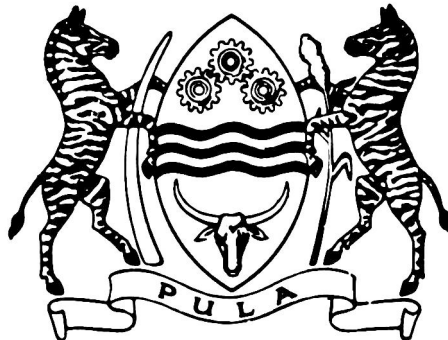

SMALL LOTTERIES (AMENDMENT) BILL, 1983

(Published on 3rd June, 1983)

MEMORANDUM

A draft of the above Bill, which it is proposed to present to the National Assembly, is set out below.

2. The object of the Bill is to amend the Small Lotteries Act (Cap. 19:02) in a number of respects.

3. By substituting a new section 6 (1) (c) of the principal Act, the Bill proposes to abolish the prohibition of lottery prizes exceeding P8 000 in amount or value and to increase the maximum price at which lottery tickets or chances may be sold from P1 to P2.

4. By deleting section 6 (1) (g) of the principal Act, the Bill proposes to abolish the prohibition of the sale of lottery tickets or chances in excess of the total value of P10 000.

5. By deleting section 6 (1) (j) of the principal Act, the Bill proposes to abolish the prohibition of sending lottery tickets through the post to persons who are not members of the society promoting the lottery. This would permit, for example, the selling and sending of lottery tickets by post to non-members outside Botswana.

6. Finally, the Bill proposes to amend the long and short titles of the Act in order that they may be consistent with the fact that, by reason of the proposed amendments, the Act would permit lottery prizes of unlimited value and the sale of an unlimited number of lottery tickets and chances.
