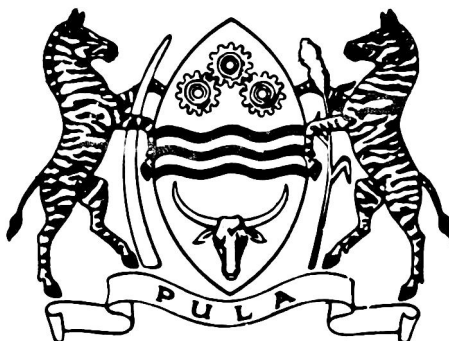

Notice of Defaulting Occupiers
