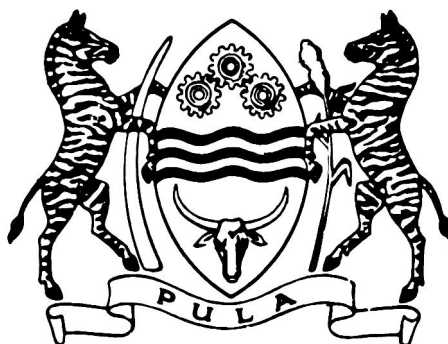

(S.I. 137 of 1982)

(regulation 6)

Notice of Defaulting Occupiers

IT IS HEREBY NOTIFIED, in performance of the duty imposed by regulation 6 of the Regulations, that there is owed by and due from each of the persons named in the first column of the Schedule, being the holder of a Certificate of Rights in respect of the Plot of State Land situated within the Selebi-Phikwe Township the number of which is specified in the corresponding entry in the second column of the Schedule, the amount specified in the corresponding entry in the third column of the Schedule, which amount represents the amount owed by and due from him or her of the service levy imposed on him or her, as the occupier of the said plot, by the Selebi-Phikwe Town Council under section 4A of the Act, and the amount specified in the corresponding entry in the fourth column of the Schedule, which amount represents the amount owed by and due from him or her of instalments towards repayment of a Building Material Loan granted him or her, as occupier of the said plot, by the Selebi-Phikwe Town Council under section 4c of the Act.

2. The Selebi-Phikwe Town Council is now required by regulation 7(1) of the Regulations forthwith to apply to the Magistrate's Court at Selebi-Phikwe for an order to sell any movable property of each of the aforementioned persons in satisfaction of his or her default in payment of the service levy and Building Material Loan repayment instalments in question and of the interest accruing in respect thereof.

3. The aforementioned Court may make the aforementioned order after the expiry of the period of 14 days immediately following the day on which the Town Council's application is made to it; but the Court may decline to make such an order if, before the expiry of that 14 days' period, payment is made into the Court of not less than 25 per cent of the amount then owed and due and of the amount of any court fees incurred up to the date of the payment by the Selebi-Phikwe Town Council and instead make an order for payment by instalments over a period of 12 months

**CRIMINAL PROCEDURE AND EVIDENCE (AMENDMENT) BILL,
1983**

(Published on 15th July, 1983)

MEMORANDUM

A draft of the above Bill, which it is proposed to present to the National Assembly, is set out below.

2. The object of the Bill is to amend the Criminal Procedure and Evidence Act (Cap. 08:02) in four respects.

3. The Act provides that the medical or post-mortem examination report of a medical practitioner or officer may be put in evidence in criminal proceedings without calling the medical practitioner or officer as a witness to produce the report. Use of this procedure saves many valuable professional man-hours better devoted to the sick.

4. Clause 2 of the Bill proposes to amend the material section of the Act, section 222, in order to allow the report of an intern or houseman also to be put in evidence without calling its maker to produce it.

5. As the law stands at present, evidence that something was pointed out by an accused person or that a fact was discovered in consequence of information given by an accused person is not admissible in evidence against him if that pointing out or information forms part of a confession which is not admissible in evidence against him.

6. Clause 3 of the Bill proposes to amend the material section of the Act, section 228, in order to remedy this situation by rendering such evidence admissible against an accused person.

7 Thirdly, clause 4 of the Bill proposes to insert a new section 247A in the Act whereby a policeman, who believes there are reasonable grounds to suppose that the accounts of a bank may afford evidence as to the commission of any offence, may obtain a warrant from a magistrate or justice of the peace authorizing the policeman or policemen named in the warrant to inspect those accounts and make and retain copies or other record of them.

8. Fourthly, and lastly, clause 5 of the Bill proposes to amend section 301 of the Act so that a person sentenced to undergo corporal punishment for rape or attempted rape shall be punished in the manner introduced for certain offences by the Criminal Procedure and Evidence (Amendment) Act, 1982, (21 of 1982). This means that a person so sentenced shall receive four strokes, in traditional manner with a traditional instrument, in such places as may be specified, each quarter in the first and last years of his term of imprisonment.
