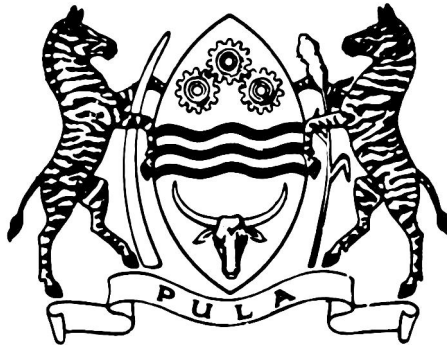

The new note will circulate side by side with the existing One Pula note.

- (e) facsimilies of the signatures of the Minister of Finance and the Governor of the Bank;

On the reverse, the inscription in Setswana stating —

- (f) the name "Banka ya Botswana";
- (g) the amount in words and figures
- (h) the slogan "Lemang Dijo".

As soon as practicable after the raising of the loan, the Minister shall lay before the National Assembly a paper containing a report on the loan which shall include the terms and conditions of the loan and any other information relating thereto which the Minister considers appropriate to include.
