

### BOTSWANA SAVINGS BANK ACT (Cap. 56:03)

### Save-As-You-Earn Contractual Savings Scheme

IN PURSUANCE of the provision of section 20(4) of the Botswana Savings Bank Act, notice is hereby given that the Minister of Finance and Development Planning has directed that a Scheme to be known as the Save-As-You-Earn (S.A.E) — Contractual Savings Scheme should be established for the purpose of enabling salaried and self-employed persons including farmers and businessmen to participate in a planned and consistent Savings Scheme involving monthly deposits of a specific amount over a fixed period.

2. In consequence of such direction, the Save-As-You-Earn (S.A.Y.E.) — Contractual Savings Scheme has been established with effect from 1st June, 1985, the terms and conditions of the Scheme are set out in the Schedule hereto.

### SCHEDULE

1. The Scheme is open to the General Public.

2. Any person who joins the Scheme will be required to deposit with the Bank a minimum of P20 a month for a period of 24 consecutive months.

3. The rate of interest payable on deposits is 7,5% per annum.

4. A bonus of 10% of the total interest earned will be payable to the depositor at the end of every 24 consecutive months.

5. All interest earned and bonus are exempt from income tax.

6. Premature deductions with the Scheme will be allowed under certain conditions but in all cases of premature withdrawal from the Scheme, no bonus will be paid and the interest will be reduced to 4,5%.
