FAUNA CONSERVATION (UNIFIED HUNTING) REGULATIONS

1990 Open Season - Hunting and Live Capture Quotas

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the Chief Game Warden by regulation 16(1) of the Fauna Conservation (Unified Hunting) Regulations, and after consultation with the relevant local authorities and land boards, it is hereby determined that during the 1990 open session —

- (a) the number of animals which may be hunted in the controlled hunting areas specified in paragraph 2 or in any other areas —
 - (i) by a citizen, is that shown against the species in the first column in relation to the area under which it appears in the second column of Part I of the Schedule hereto;
 - (ii) by a resident, who is not a citizen, is that shown against the species in the first column in relation to the area under which it appears in the second column in Part II of the said Schedule;
 - (iii) by a non-resident, is that shown against the species in the first column in relation to the area under which it appears in the second column in Parts III and IV of the Schedule; and
- (b) the number of animals and ostriches which may be captured alive throughout Botswana is that shown in the second and fourth columns against the species in the first and third columns in Parts V, VI and VII of the Schedule.

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the Minister of Presidential Affairs and Public Administration by section 20(1) of the Control of Security Guard Services Act, the following Regulations are hereby made —

Citation

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Control of Security Guard Services (Amendment) Regulations, 1990.

Application for licence

- 2.(1) An application for a security guard licence shall be made to the Controller in a form that may be prescribed and shall contain all the information specified in section 5 of the Act.
- (2) An applicant or his representative shall, if requested by the Controller to do so, furnish in writing any further information that the Controller may require, or, where the Controller seeks to interview him or his representative, attend such interview.

Issue of licence

- 3. (1) The Controller shall, after consideration of an application made under regulation 2, issue the applicant with a licence upon payment by the applicant of the fee prescribed in regulation 15.
- (2) The Controller shall, in writing inform the applicant of his decision regarding his application for a licence in a manner that may conform in substantial detail to a form that may be prescribed.

Period of validity of licence 4. A licence issued under these Regulations shall, unless previously cancelled or surrendered, be valid for 12 months from the date on which it was issued.

Renewal of

licence

5. (1) A licence may, upon its expiry, be renewed by application to the Controller in a form that may be prescribed, and every such application shall be accompanied by the fee prescribed in regulation 15.

(2) Every application for the renewal of a licence shall be made not

later than 2 months before the licence expires.

¢

(3) The Controller shall, in writing, inform the applicant of his decision regarding his application for renewal of a licence in a form that may be prescribed.

6. No person who has been issued with a licence shall transfer such licence to any other person without first obtaining the written consent of the Controller.

Restriction transfer of

7. Every licensee shall display his licence in a conspicuous place in his business premises.

8. (1) Every licensee shall maintain a record of names of his employees, dates of their employment, dates of termination of their services and the reasons for such termination.

Display of licence

(2) Every licensee shall submit to the Controller not later than 60 days after the end of the calender year in which his licence was issued or renewed, an annual return in respect of his employees giving the number and names of his employees, and the names of employees dismissed from his employ.

Maintenance of records and annual returns

9. Every licensee shall make available for inspection by the Controller or a police officer upon demand his licence or any record in respect of his

Inspection of records

10.(1) Every licensee shall ensure that whenever a security guard is on duty such security guard displays on his person an identity card which shall be in a form that may be prescribed.

Display of indentity cards

(2) It shall be an offence for a security guard not to display his identity card on his person whenever he is on duty.

(3) Any person who contravenes the provisions of sub-regulation (2) of this regulation shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine of P50 or to imprisonment for 3 months in default of payment.

11. No licensee shall employ (from within or outside Botswana) as a security guard any person who has been convicted of an offence involving moral turpitude or against whom criminal proceedings are pending.

Employment of security guards with convictions

12. (1) No licensee shall display or cause to be displayed any advertisement which is indecent or in any way objectionable, or which does not relate to the services which he offers or renders.

Control of advertise-

(2) Any person who contravenes the provisions of this regulation shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable to a fine of P50 or to imprisonment for 3 months in default of payment.

13. (1) Where the Controller has decided to cancel or suspend a licence in accordance with section 11 of the Act the licensee shall surrender such licence for endorsement or cancellation or suspension as the case may be to the Controller, within the period specified by the

Cancellation and surrender of licences

(2) The Controller shall give his decision to cancel or suspend a licence in a form that may be prescribed.

14. Any person aggrieved by the decision of the Controller not to Appeals issue him with a licence or renew his licence may appeal to the Minister.

Fces

- 15. The following fees shall be payable to the Controller: —
- (a) P300 in respect of an application for the issue of a licence;
- (b) P200 in respect of an application for renewal of a licence;
- (c) P100 in respect of an appeal to the Minister against the decision of the Controller.

Offences and penalties 16. Any person who contravenes any provision of these Regulations, for which no other penalty is prescribed, shall be guilty of an offence and liable on conviction to a fine of P1 000 or to imprisonment for 6 months in default of payment.

Repeal of S.I. 16 of 1987 17. Control of Security Guard Services Regulations, 1987 are hereby repealed.
