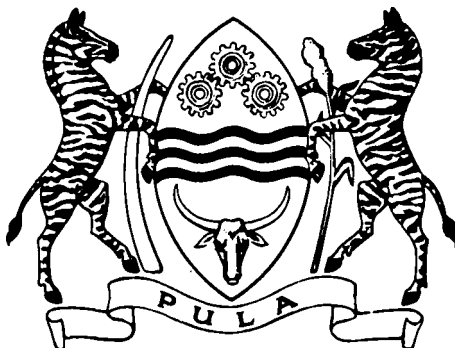

The New Fifty Pula Bank Note

Citation 1. This Order may be cited as the Rectification of the Laws (No. 3) Order, 1990.

of Cap. 36:06 2. The errors appearing in section 10(1) of the Matimela Act are hereby rectified —

- (a) by substituting for the words “may, notwithstanding that” appearing after the word “kraal” therein, a comma;
- (b) by inserting the word “a person” immediately after the words, “such matimela or” appearing therein; and
- (c) by inserting the word “may” immediately after the words “the Hypothecation Act,” appearing therein.

Cap. 52:01 3. The errors appearing in sub-subparagraphs (ii)-(iv) of subparagraph (h) of paragraph 2 of Part I of the Sixth Schedule to the Income Tax Act is hereby rectified by substituting for those sub-subparagraphs the following —

- “(ii) where the remainder exceeds three million pula (P3 000 000) but does not exceed six million pula (P6 000 000), the sum of one-fifth of such part of the remainder as exceeds three million pula (P3 000 000) and three hundred thousand pula (P300 000);
- (iii) where the remainder exceeds six million pula (P6 000 000) but does not exceed nine million pula (P9 000 000), the sum of three-tenths of such part of the remainder as exceeds six million pula (P6 000 000) and nine hundred thousand pula (P900 000); or
- (iv) where the remainder exceeds nine million pula (P9 000 000), the sum of one-third of such part of the remainder as exceeds nine million pula (P9 000 000) and one million eight hundred thousand pula (P1 800 000).”
