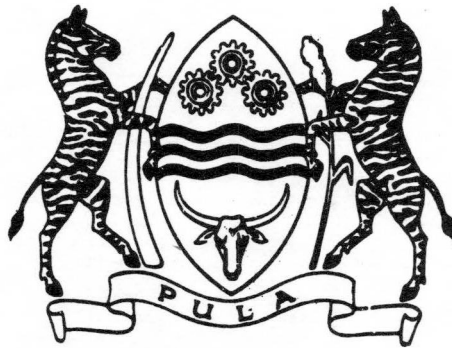

Section 37 (1) of the Precious and Semi-Precious Stones (Protection) Act is hereby amended by substituting for the words "designated by him in the notice" the words "involving rough or uncut precious or semi-precious stones, or to any operations involving the storing, manufacturing, classifying, sorting, valuing, transporting, buying or selling of such stones".
