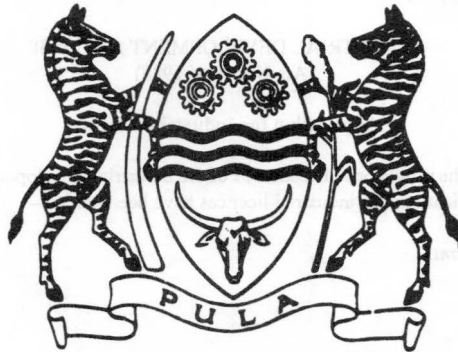

2. Under section 11 of the University of Botswana Act, the University Council has general powers "to do or provide for any act or thing in relation to the University which it considers necessary or expedient in its capacity as the governing body."

The object of this Act is to make that section more specific by enabling the University Council to prohibit the admission of any person as a student of the University, to suspend or dismiss any student, and to close the University where it believes that that is the best course of action to follow.
