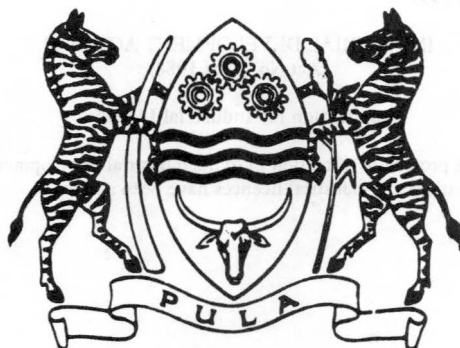

CONSTITUTION OF BOTSWANA

Authorization to Exercise Functions of the Office of President

TO: The Honourable KEBATLAMANG PITSIEYOSI MORAKE, M.P. Minister of Health

WHEREAS it is provided by section 36 (1) of the Constitution that whenever the President is absent from Botswana or considers it desirable so to do by reason of illness or any other cause he may, by directions in writing, authorize the Vice-President or in the absence of the Vice-President, a Minister, to discharge such of the functions of the office of President as he may specify, and the person so authorised may discharge those functions until the President's return to Botswana or the revocation of such authorization, as the case may be;

AND WHEREAS the Vice-President is out of the country on official business;

AND WHEREAS I intend to be absent from Botswana from the 25th August, 1991 and I consider it desirable to issue directions as aforesaid;

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested in me as aforesaid I authorize you, KEBATLAMANG PITSIEYOSI MORAKE in your capacity as Minister of Health, to discharge with effect from 25th August, 1991 all the functions of the Office of President, except —

- (a) the power to dissolve Parliament in accordance with the provisions of section 91 of the Constitution;
- (b) the power to appoint to the office of Minister or Assistant Minister in accordance with the provisions of section 42 of the Constitution;

Provided, however, that you can appoint the present Ministers or Assistant-Ministers to act in place of any Minister who is otherwise not available;

- (c) the power to remove a Minister or Assistant-Minister from office in accordance with the provision of section 43 of the Constitution;

until my return to Botswana or this authority is revoked by me which ever happens first.
