CONSTITUTION OF BOTSWANA

Authorization to Exercise Functions of the Office of President

TO: The Honourable PETER SIMAKO MMUSI, M.P. Vice-President and Minister of Local Government and Lands

WHEREAS it is provided by section 36 (1) of the Constitution that whenever the President is absent from Botswana or considers it desirable so to do by reason of illness or any other cause he may, by directions in writing, authorize the Vice-President to discharge such of the functions of the office of President as he may specify, and the Vice-President may discharge those functions until the President's return to Botswana or the revocation of such authorization, as the case may be;

AND WHEREAS I intend to be absent from Botswana from the 29th August, 1991 and I consider it desirable to issue directions as aforesaid;

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested in me as aforesaid I authorize you, PETER SIMAKO MMUSI in your capacity as Vice-President and Minister of Local Government and Lands, to discharge with effect from 29th August, 1991 all the functions of the Office of President, except —

- (a) the power to dissolve Parliament in accordance with the provisions of section 91 of the Constitution;
- (b) the power to appoint to the office of Minister or Assistant Minister in accordance with the provisions of section 42 of the Constitution:

Provided, however, that you can appoint the present Ministers or Assistant-Ministers to act in place of any Minister who is otherwise not available;

- (c) the power to remove a Minister or Assistant-Minister from office in accordance with the provision of section 43 of the Constitution;

until my return to Botswana or this authority is revoked by me, which ever happens first.

ARRANGEMENT OF BYE-LAWS

BYE-LAW

1. Citation
2. Establishment of pound
3. Appointment of poundmaster
4. Financing of pound

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by regulations 30 and 31 of the Town Council Regulations, the Jwaneng Town Council, with the approval of the Minister, hereby makes the following bye-laws —

1. These Bye-laws may be cited as the Jwaneng Town Council (Pound) Bye-Laws, 1991. Citation

2. The Jwaneng Town Council shall establish a pound to be situated and operated within the limits of the township. Establishment of pound

3. The Jwaneng Town Council shall appoint a pound master, and such other persons as may be necessary for the proper conduct of the pound in accordance with the provisions of the Pounds Act. Appointment of pound master

4. All moneys received by the poundmaster in terms of the Pounds Act shall be paid into the funds of the Jwaneng Town Council, and all costs incurred in operating the pound, and all moneys lawfully expended by the poundmaster shall be paid by the Council. Financing of pound
