CONSTITUTION OF BOTSWANA

Authorization to Exercise Functions of the Office of President

TO: The Honourable PETER SIMAKO MMUSI, M.P. Vice-President and Minister of Local Government, Lands and Housing

WHEREAS it is provided by section 36 (1) of the Constitution that whenever the President is absent from Botswana or considers it desirable so to do by reason of illness or any other cause he may, by directions in writing, authorize the Vice-President or in the absence of the Vice-President, a Minister, to discharge such of the functions of the office of President as he may specify, and the person so authorised may discharge those functions until the President's return to Botswana or the revocation of such authorization, as the case may be;

AND WHEREAS I intend to be absent from Botswana from the 15th October, 1991 and I consider it desirable to issue directions as aforesaid;

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested in me as aforesaid I authorize you, PETER SIMAKO MMUSI in your capacity as Vice-President and Minister of Local Government Lands and Housing, to discharge with effect from 15th October, 1991 all the functions of the Office of President, except —

- (a) the power to dissolve Parliament in accordance with the provisions of section 91 of the Constitution;
- (b) the power to appoint to the office of Minister or Assistant Minister in accordance with the provisions of section 42 of the Constitution:

Provided, however, that you can appoint the present Ministers or Assistant-Ministers to act in place of any Minister who is otherwise not available;

- (c) the power to remove a Minister or Assistant-Minister from office in accordance with the provisions of section 43 of the Constitution;

until my return to Botswana or this authority is revoked by me which ever happens first.

(b) Where a company is listed on the Botswana Stock Exchange on the 1st July, 1991, it shall be entitled to the deduction under paragraph (a), if supported by a certificate such as is referred to in paragraph (a), for the tax year 1991/1992 and for the four immediately succeeding tax years.

(5) No person shall be entitled to any deduction under this Part except upon due claim and subject to the production of such evidence as the Commissioner may require.

(6) For the purposes of this section, the expression “general public” shall, without prejudice to its generally accepted meaning, be deemed to include any approved benefit, pension or superannuation fund and any other fund which, in the opinion of the commissioner, is of a public character.”.

132. (1) For the purposes of this Act the expression "private company", in respect of each tax year, means —

(a) a company which by its memorandum or articles of association —

- (i) restricts the right to transfer its shares;
- (ii) limits the number of its members to fifty, not including persons who are in the employment of the company and persons who have been formerly in the employment of the company and who were while in that employment and after the termination of that employment, members of the company; or
- (iii) prohibits any invitation to the general public to subscribe for any shares or debentures of the company;

(b) a company whose membership is less than seven persons; or

(c) a company which is not recognised as a public company, either by the Registrar of Companies under the Companies Act, or by the Commissioner under this Act.

(2) For the purposes of this Act, a company, not being a private company, shall be recognised as a public company in relation to a tax year if —

(a) in the case of a resident company —

- (i) all classes of its shares are listed for quotation on the Botswana Stock Exchange on the last day of the tax year or any substituted accounting period and the general public, throughout the tax year either directly as shareholders or indirectly as shareholders in any other public company, held more than fifty per cent of every class of equity share issued by the company;

Provided that in respect of a tax year prior to the establishment of the Botswana Stock Exchange all classes of its shares are listed for quotation by Stock brokers Botswana Ltd. with the approval of the Interim Stock Exchange Committee appointed by the Minister;

- (ii) it is a subsidiary of a public company;
- (iii) it is an insurance company transacting life insurance business;

(iv) it is a society or company registered under the Cooperative Societies Act; or

(v) it is a specified corporation;

(b) in the case of a non-resident company, it is recognised as a public company under the law of the country in which it is resident.

(3) For the purposes of subsections (1) and (2) the expression "general public" shall have the same meaning as in section 50, and for the purposes of subsection (2) (a) (ii), a company shall be deemed to be a subsidiary of a public company if one or more companies which are public companies, throughout the tax year, hold more than fifty per cent of every class of equity shares issued by the company.

(4) Where, by reason of changes in the constitution or shareholding of any company or for any other reason, a company which has been recognised as a public company ceases to satisfy the requirements of subsection (2) in any tax year, such company shall be recognised as a private company in relation to that tax year."

Board of Adjudicators

1. For the purposes of Part XII, the Minister may by notice in the Gazette appoint three suitable persons to serve as members of the Board of Adjudicators, and shall appoint one of their number to be the Chairman of the Board.

2. Members of the Board shall be appointed for a period of five years, but shall be eligible for reappointment.

3. Vacancies in the Board, for any reason, may be filled by appointments made by the Minister in the same manner as in paragraph 1, and temporary vacancies may be filled by temporary appointments made in the same manner.

4. At any meeting of the Board, the Chairman and any other member shall form a quorum, and in the event of an equal division of opinion amongst those present, the Chairman shall have a casting vote.

5. The members of the Board shall receive such remuneration and travelling and other allowances out of public funds as the Minister shall determine.

6. The Board shall have the following powers -

- (a) power to summon to attend at the hearing of an appeal any person who in its opinion is or might be able to give evidence relevant to the subject of the appeal;
- (b) power to examine on oath or otherwise any person summoned or required to give evidence;
- (c) power to require any person to produce any books or documents which are in his custody or under his control and which the Board considers necessary for the purposes of the appeal;
- (d) power to grant reimbursement of any reasonable expenses incurred in connexion with his attendance by any person summoned to attend;
- (e) all the powers of a magistrate with regard to the enforcement of attendance of witnesses hearing evidence on oath and punishment for contempt of court;
- (f) power to admit or reject evidence adduced, whether or not admissible under the provisions of any written law for the time being in force relating to the admissibility of evidence;
- (g) power to postpone the hearing of an appeal where the Board is satisfied that, owing to sickness, accident or other reasonable cause the appellant has been prevented from attending on the date fixed for the hearing; and
- (h) such other powers as the Minister may, by regulations, prescribe.”

Transitional

19. Consequent upon the amendments introduced by sections 7 and 18 of this Act, the Commissioner may refer any appeal that, at the date of commencement of this Act, is pending before an Appeals Committee, to the Board of Adjudicators established under this Act.

“(2) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (1), it shall not be an offence under this section if a pregnancy is terminated or an abortion is caused within the first 16 weeks of pregnancy, in the following circumstances and under the following conditions —

 - (a) where the medical practitioner carrying out the operation is satisfied, by acceptable evidence, that the pregnancy is the result of rape, defilement or incest, and the termination or abortion is requested by the victim, or, where the victim lacks the capacity to make such request, by her next of kin or guardian or the person in loco parentis; or
 - (b) where the continuance of the pregnancy would involve risk to the life of the pregnant woman or injury to her physical or mental health, and such woman consents to the termination or abortion, or, if she lacks the capacity to give such consent, it is given on her behalf by her next of kin or guardian or the person in loco parentis; or

- (c) where established evidence shows that there is a substantial risk that, if the child were born, it would suffer from or later develop such serious physical or mental abnormality or disease as to be seriously handicapped, and the pregnant woman consents to the termination or abortion, or, if she lacks the capacity to give such consent, it is given on her behalf by her next of kin or guardian or the person in loco parentis:

Provided that —

- (i) the termination or abortion is carried out by a registered medical practitioner in a Government hospital or a registered private hospital, or a clinic approved for the purpose by the Director of Health Services; and
- (ii) two medical practitioners have given their opinions formed in good faith, in writing, in the case of paragraph (b) above, that continuation of the pregnancy would involve risk to the life of the pregnant woman or injury to her physical or mental health, or, in the case of paragraph (c) above, that there is substantial risk that, if the child was allowed to be born, it would suffer such serious physical or mental abnormality or disease as to be seriously handicapped."
