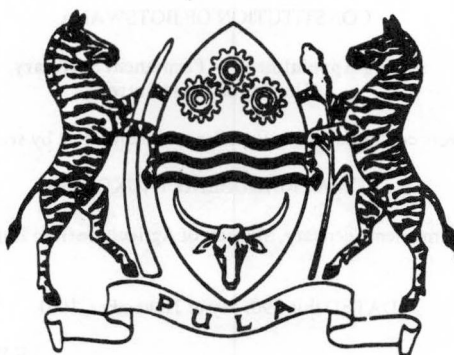

CONSTITUTION OF BOTSWANA

Authorization to Exercise Functions of the Office of President

TO: THE HONOURABLE KEBATLAMANG PITSIEYOSI MORAKE, M.P. MINISTER OF HEALTH

WHEREAS it is provided by section 36 (1) of the Constitution that whenever the President is absent from Botswana or considers it desirable so to do by reason of illness or any other cause he may, by directions in writing, authorize the Vice-President or in the absence of the Vice-President, a Minister, to discharge such of the functions of the office of President as he may specify, and the person so authorised may discharge those functions until the President's return to Botswana or the revocation of such authorization, as the case may be;

AND WHEREAS the Vice-President is out of the country on official business;

AND WHEREAS I intend to be absent from Botswana from 3rd of December, 1991 and I consider it desirable to issue directions as aforesaid;

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested in me as aforesaid I authorize you, KEBATLAMANG PITSIEYOSI MORAKE in your capacity as Minister of Health, to discharge with effect from 3rd December, 1991 all the functions of the office of President, except —

- (a) the power to dissolve Parliament in accordance with the provisions of section 91 of the Constitution;
- (b) the power to appoint to the office of Minister or Assistant Minister in accordance with the provisions of section 42 of the Constitution:
Provided, however, that you can appoint the present Ministers or Assistant Ministers to act in place of any Minister who is otherwise not available;
- (c) the power to remove a Minister or Assistant Minister from office in accordance with the provisions of section 43 of the Constitution;

until my return to Botswana or this authority is revoked by me which ever happens first.

GABORONE REGION TELEMETRY SCHEME

TENDERS ARE INVITED by the Water Utilities Corporation from suitably qualified contractors for the implementation of a Regional Telemetry Scheme to monitor the water resources and supply system around Gaborone.

The Gaborone Regional system will comprise approximately thirty outstations, twelve of which will be remote with a radio link to the Regional Control Centre. The remaining will be local to the Regional Control centre and will be direct wire linked. The total number of signals, to be monitored by an IBM based data processing system, will be approximately 500 digital and 150 analogue. (3) The Board of Trustees may appoint an executive director and training and administrative staff to administer the Fund on such terms and conditions, and at such remuneration as the Board may, from time to time, direct.

5. There shall be paid into the Fund —

- (a) P2 875 000 provided by the Government to establish the Fund;
 - (b) such sums as may be raised by a levy of 0,25% on all construction contracts awarded by the Central Tender Board, to be matched by the Government by a similar amount; and
 - (c) any moneys accrued or realised from investments made in accordance with paragraph 6.

6. The Board of Trustees shall, as far as is reasonably practicable, invest or direct the investment of all moneys of the Fund not immediately required for payments from the Fund in accordance with paragraph 7, in such investments, Investment of Fund moneys

and on such terms as shall, in its opinion, contribute to the achievement of the objectives of the Fund, and any interest earned from such investments shall accrue to the Fund.
