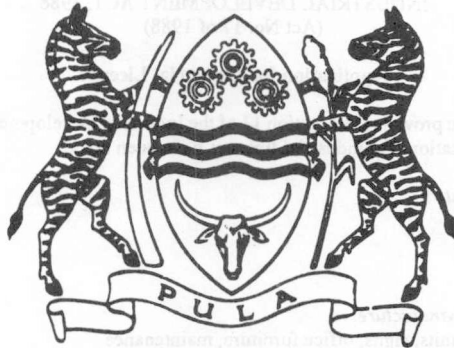

**FAUNA CONSERVATION ACT**  
(Cap. 38:01)

**DECLARATION OF PRIVATE GAME RESERVE ORDER, 1992**  
(Published on 31st January, 1992)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 9 of the Fauna Conservation Act, the President of Botswana hereby makes the following Order —

1. This Order may be cited as the Declaration of Private Game Reserve Order, 1992. Citation

2. The area of land described in the Schedule hereto is hereby declared to be a private game reserve for the protection and preservation therein of all species of wild animal life indigenous to, or that were once indigenous to, that area, to provide an orphanage for orphaned, injured or confiscated wild animals and birds, and to make the area available under suitable management for purposes of education and tourism. Declaration of private game reserve

3. (1) Any breeding or cross-breeding scheme involving the introduction of wildlife species into the reserve, and the culling or capture of animals therein, shall be subject to the prior permission of the Director of Wildlife Conservation and National Parks, and to such terms and conditions as he may determine, or as may be prescribed by or under the Act. Restrictions in respect of certain

(2) Any development or arrangement of facilities for the purpose of breeding, putting on display, trading or rehabilitation of animals shall require the prior approval of the Director and be subject to such terms and conditions as he may determine or as may be prescribed by or under the Act.

(3) Any permission, approval, or authorization by the Director may be withdrawn at any time if, in his opinion, no reasonable or satisfactory steps have been taken to introduce good land and wildlife management practices, including the provision of adequate water facilities for the animals, or fire-breaks for the control of veldt fires.
