CONSTITUTION OF BOTSWANA

Authorization to Exercise Functions of the Office of President

TO: THE HONOURABLE PETER SIMAKO MMUSI, M.P., VICE-PRESIDENT,
MINISTER OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT, LANDS AND HOUSING.

WHEREAS it is provided by section 36 (1) of the Constitution that whenever the President is absent from Botswana or considers it desirable so to do by reason of illness or any other cause he may, by directions in writing, authorize the Vice-President to discharge such of the functions of the office of President as he may specify, and the Vice-President may discharge those functions until the President's return to Botswana or the revocation of such authorization, as the case may be;

AND WHEREAS I intend to be absent from Botswana from the 27th February, 1992 and I consider it desirable to issue directions as aforesaid;

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested in me as aforesaid I authorize you, PETER SIMAKO MMUSI in your capacity as Vice-President and Minister of Local Government, Lands and Housing to discharge with effect from 27th February, 1992 all the functions of the Office of President, except —

- (a) the power to dissolve Parliament in accordance with the provisions of section 91 of the Constitution;
- (b) the power to appoint to the office of Minister or Assistant Minister in accordance with the provisions of section 42 of the Constitution;

Provided, however, that you can appoint the present Ministers or Assistant Ministers to act in place of any Minister who is otherwise not available;

- (c) the power to remove a Minister or Assistant Minister from office in accordance with the provisions of section 43 of the Constitution;

until my return to Botswana or this authority is revoked by me which ever happens first.

The Bill seeks to re-enact the National Assembly (Salaries and Allowances) Act to bring into effect the recently announced 10 per cent increase in salaries and allowances.

1. This Act may be cited as the National Assembly (Salaries and Allowances) Act, 1992, and shall come into operation on 1st April, 1992.

2. In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires —

“Leader of the Opposition” means the person designated by the Speaker of the Assembly as Leader of the Opposition;

Salaries and allowances of Speaker and Deputy Speaker

"Member" has the meaning assigned to it under section 58 of the Constitution.

3. (1) The Speaker and Deputy Speaker of the National Assembly shall each be paid, from moneys appropriated by law for such purpose, the appropriate salary payable in terms of section 4.

(2) The Speaker and Deputy Speaker shall, in addition, receive the allowance specified in paragraph 8 of the Schedule and shall be eligible to receive the allowances payable to Members under paragraphs 2 and 3 of the Schedule.

Salaries and allowances of Members

4. Members shall be paid, from moneys appropriated by law for such purpose, the salaries and allowances prescribed in the Schedule.

Payment of pension to spouse of deceased President

5. (1) The surviving spouse of a President who dies in office shall be paid, from moneys appropriated by law for such purpose, the pension specified in the Schedule.

(2) A pension paid under this section shall be exempt from income tax.

Allowances exempt from income tax

6. The allowances payable or benefits granted in terms of this Act shall be exempt from income tax.

Saving in respect of other allowances

7. Nothing in this Act shall be deemed to prohibit the payment to any Member of any subsistence or other allowance in respect of the performance by him of duties as a Minister or Assistant Minister, or as a Member of any board or committee appointed to advise any Minister, or for any other purpose.

Repeal of Act No. 6 of 1988

8. The National Assembly (Salaries and Allowances) Act is hereby repealed.

Salary

1. (1) Each Member, other than the Attorney-General, shall receive a salary calculated, in the case of—

- (a) the President, at the rate of P74 748 per annum;
- (b) the Vice-President, at the rate of P59 592 per annum;
- (c) any other Minister, other than an Assistant Minister, at the rate of P46 452 per annum;
- (d) an Assistant Minister, at the rate of P41 664 per annum;
- (e) the Speaker, at the rate P32 532 per annum;
- (f) the Leader of Opposition, at the rate of P30 360 per annum;
- (g) the Deputy Speaker, at the rate of P30 192 per annum;
- (h) any other member, at the rate of P27 312 per annum.

(2) A surviving spouse of a President who dies in office shall receive a pension at the rate of P36 888 per annum.

Sitting allowance

2. (1) Every Member, other than the Attorney General, who attends a meeting of the Assembly or of a committee of the Assembly shall receive an allowance calculated as follows —

- (a) in the case of a Minister, or Assistant Minister, at the rate of P72,60; and
- (b) in the case of any other Member, at the rate of P107,25, for every day on which he attends such meeting.

(2) The Attorney-General shall receive an allowance, when he attends a meeting of —

- (a) the Assembly, at the rate of P72,60; and
- (b) a committee of the Assembly, at the rate of P107,25,

for every day on which he attends such meeting.

3. (1) Every Member, other than a Minister, Assistant Minister and the Attorney-General, shall receive an allowance, calculated in accordance with the provisions of subparagraph (2), in respect of one return journey undertaken by him by the shortest convenient route in his own motor vehicle or by a public road, rail or air service — Transport allowance

- (a) from his home to any meeting of the Assembly, or to any committee thereof of which he is a member held while the Assembly is not sitting; and
- (b) from any such meeting to his home during any adjournment of such meeting of three clear days or longer.

(2) Such allowance shall be —

- (a) where the journey or any part thereof is performed in the Member's own vehicle, at the rate for the time being applicable to public officers;
- (b) where the journey or any part thereof is performed by any public road, rail or air service, a sum equal to the fare actually paid up to a maximum of the ordinary first class fare payable on such service.

Provided that, where he ceases to be a Member by reason of a dissolution of Parliament, he shall be deemed to have continued to be a Member until midnight of the night prior to polling day at the general election.

(2) No termination allowance shall be payable to a Member who ceases to hold office by virtue of section 68 (1) (b) or (c) of the Constitution.

(3) If a Minister or Assistant Minister ceases to hold office as such, that proportion of the allowance attributable to the difference between his salary as Minister or Assistant Minister, as the case may be, and the salary paid to a Member under paragraph 1(h) may be withheld, in whole or in part, at the discretion of the President.

2. The purpose of this Bill is to re-enact the Judges (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act in order to bring into effect the recently announced 10 per cent increase in salaries and allowances and also to clarify the provisions relating to the calculation and payment of gratuities to judges.

3. A judge is entitled to be paid gratuity at the end of a tour of service. A tour of service is a period of either two years or three years and begins on the date of assumption of office by a judge. Gratuity is payable on basic salary.

4. Sections 4 and 5 provide, among other things, that where a judge, including the Chief Justice, is not in receipt of inducement allowance, he shall be paid an annual allowance calculated at the rate of 15 per cent of the basic salary payable to him.
