REGULATION OF MINIMUM WAGES ORDER, 1992
(Published on 3rd April, 1992)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 142 of the Employment Act, the Minister of Labour and Home Affairs, having duly considered the recommendations of the Minimum Wages Advisory Board, hereby makes the following Order —

1. This Order may be cited as the Regulation of Minimum Wages Order, 1992, and shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st April, 1992. Citation and
