IN PURSUANCE of the provisions of section 2 of the Commissions of Inquiry Act, a Commission of Inquiry entitled the National Commission on Education (hereinafter referred to as "the Commission") is hereby set up.

- (c) to advise on an education system that is sensitive and responsive to the aspirations of the people and manpower requirements of the country;
- (d) to study the various possible methods of students streaming into vocational and academic groups at senior secondary level;
- (e) to study how the secondary structure at senior level may relate to the University of Botswana degree programmes and how the two programmes may best be reconciled;
- (f) to advise on the organisation and diversification of the secondary school curricula that will prepare adequately and effectively those that are unable to proceed with higher education; and
- (g) to make recommendations to Government on the best and cost effective methods of implementation of the final recommendations.

5. The report of the Commission shall be submitted by September, 1992.

1. This Act may be cited as the National Assembly (Salaries and Allowances) Act, 1992, and shall come into operation on 1st April, 1992.

2. In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires —

“Assembly” means the National Assembly;

“Leader of the Opposition” means the person designated by the Speaker of the Assembly as Leader of the Opposition;

“Member” has the meaning assigned to it under section 58 of the Constitution.

3. (1) The Speaker and Deputy Speaker of the National Assembly shall each be paid, from moneys appropriated by law for such purpose, the appropriate salary payable in terms of section 4.

(2) The Speaker and Deputy Speaker shall, in addition, receive the allowance specified in paragraph 8 of the Schedule and shall be eligible to receive the allowances payable to Members under paragraphs 2 and 3 of the Schedule.

Salaries and allowances of Members

4. Members shall be paid, from moneys appropriated by law for such purpose, the salaries and allowances prescribed in the Schedule.

Payment of pension to spouse of deceased President

5. (1) The surviving spouse of a President who dies in office shall be paid, from moneys appropriated by law for such purpose, the pension specified in the Schedule.

(2) A pension paid under this section shall be exempt from income tax.

Allowances exempt from income tax

6. The allowances payable or benefits granted in terms of this Act shall be exempt from income tax.

Saving in respect of other allowances

7. Nothing in this Act shall be deemed to prohibit the payment to any Member of any subsistence or other allowance in respect of the performance by him of duties as a Minister or Assistant Minister, or as a Member of any board or committee appointed to advise any Minister, or for any other purpose.

Repeal of Act No. 6 of 1988

8. The National Assembly (Salaries and Allowances) Act is hereby repealed.

Salary

1. (1) Each Member, other than the Attorney-General, shall receive a salary calculated, in the case of—

- (a) the President, at the rate of P74 748 per annum;
- (b) the Vice-President, at the rate of P59 592 per annum;
- (c) any other Minister, other than an Assistant Minister, at the rate of P46 452 per annum;
- (d) an Assistant Minister, at the rate of P41 664 per annum;
- (e) the Speaker, at the rate of P32 532 per annum;

(2) The Attorney-General shall receive an allowance, when he attends a meeting of —

- (a) the Assembly, at the rate of P72,60; and
 - (b) a committee of the Assembly, at the rate of P107,25,
- for every day on which he attends such meeting.

Transport allowance

3. (1) Every Member, other than a Minister, Assistant Minister and the Attorney-General, shall receive an allowance, calculated in accordance with the provisions of subparagraph (2), in respect of one return journey undertaken by him by the shortest convenient route in his own motor vehicle or by a public road, rail or air service —

(a) from his home to any meeting of the Assembly, or to any committee thereof of which he is a member held while the Assembly is not sitting; and

(a) where the journey or any part thereof is performed in the Member's own vehicle, at the rate for the time being applicable to public officers;

(b) where the journey or any part thereof is performed by any public road, rail or air service, a sum equal to the fare actually paid up to a maximum of the ordinary first class fare payable on such service.

Provided that, where he ceases to be a Member by reason of a dissolution of Parliament, he shall be deemed to have continued to be a Member until midnight of the night prior to polling day at the general election.

(2) No termination allowance shall be payable to a Member who ceases to hold office by virtue of section 68 (1) (b) or (c) of the Constitution.

(3) If a Minister or Assistant Minister ceases to hold office as such, that proportion of the allowance attributable to the difference between his salary as Minister or Assistant Minister, as the case may be, and the salary paid to a Member under paragraph 1 (1) (h) may be withheld, in whole or in part, at the discretion of the President.
