TO: THE HONOURABLE FESTUS GONTEBANYE MOGAE, M.P., VICE-PRESIDENT AND
MINISTER OF FINANCE AND DEVELOPMENT PLANNING.

WHEREAS it is provided by section 36 (1) of the Constitution that whenever the President is absent from Botswana or considers it desirable so to do by reason of illness or any other cause he may, by directions in writing, authorize the Vice-President to discharge such of the functions of the office of President as he may specify, and the Vice-President may discharge those functions until the President's return to Botswana or the revocation of such authorization, as the case may be;

AND WHEREAS I intend to be absent from Botswana from the 22nd April, 1992 and I consider it desirable to issue directions as aforesaid;

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested in me as aforesaid I authorize you, FESTUS GONTEBANYE MOGAE in your capacity as Vice-President and Minister of Finance and Development Planning to discharge with effect from 22nd April, 1992 all the functions of the Office of President, except —

ENACTED by the Parliament of Botswana

1. This Act may be cited as the Judges (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act, 1992, and shall come into operation on 1st April, 1992. Short title and commencement
2. In this Act, "puisne judge" means any judge of the High Court of Botswana other than the Chief Justice. Interpretation
3. (1) There shall be paid to the President of the Court of Appeal, in addition to the amounts specified in subsection (2), an allowance at the rate of P5 400 a year. Remuneration of Justices of Appeal
- (2) There shall be paid to every Justice of Appeal —
 - (a) a fee of P475,20 in respect of every session of the Court of Appeal attended by that judge;
 - (b) a fee of P1188 for each day necessarily occupied by the judge in travelling to the seat of the Court, attending the session of the Court, and returning home after its conclusion;
 - (c) a subsistence allowance of P47,82 per day, or the cost of any hotel accommodation necessarily incurred (whichever is the greater) in respect of each day necessarily occupied in the manner specified in paragraph (b).

4. The Chief Justice shall be paid —
- (a) a salary at the rate of P108 456 a year ;
 - (b) in the case of a Chief Justice who is not in receipt of inducement allowance, an annual allowance calculated at the rate of 15 per cent of the salary payable under paragraph (a);
 - (c) in the case of a Chief Justice whose service is not by virtue of any law pensionable, a gratuity determined in accordance with the provisions of section 6;
 - (d) an entertainment allowance at the rate of P1 431 a year.

5. A puisne judge shall be paid —
- (a) a salary at the rate of P82 008 a year;
 - (b) in the case of a judge who is not in receipt of inducement allowance, an annual allowance calculated at the rate of 15 per cent of the salary payable under paragraph (a);
 - (c) in the case of a judge whose service is not by virtue of any law pensionable, a gratuity determined in accordance with the provisions of sections 6.

Accrual

6. A gratuity shall accrue and be payable —
- (a) at the end of each tour of service, a tour of service being a period of either two years or three years, as the case maybe, from a date beginning with a judge's assumption of office;
 - (b) upon vacation of office by the judge consequent upon reaching the retiring age for judges;
 - (c) upon vacation of office by the judge on medical grounds; or
 - (d) upon the death of the judge whilst holding office.

Calculation
of gratuity

7. (1) A gratuity accruing and payable in accordance with the provisions of section 6 shall be calculated on the basis of the salary payable to the judge (which expression shall hereinafter include the Chief Justice) in accordance with section 4 (a) or section 5 (a), as the case may be.

(2) The gratuity shall be payable at the rate of 25 per cent for the first tour of the judge's service, 27,5 per cent for the second tour, and 30 per cent for the third and any subsequent tour.

8. Any gratuity or allowance payable under this Act (other than an allowance paid in pursuance of section 4 (b) and section 5 (b)) shall be exempt from income tax.

"(a) (i) For the purpose of assessing the excise duty on any goods specified in Section A of Part 2 of Schedule No. 1, (other than goods specified in items 117.01.10 and 117.05 to 117.30), the value thereof shall be the price paid or payable for such goods when sold for home consumption in the ordinary course of trade, in the usual trade packing, where applicable, to any buyers not deemed to be related as specified in section 72 (2) (a), plus any non-rebated excise duty payable in terms of Section B of Part 2 of Schedule No. 1, but excluding the non-rebated excise duty payable in terms of Section A of Part 2 of Schedule No. 1 on such goods.

(ii) For the purpose of assessing the excise duty on any goods specified in items 117.01.10 and 117.05 to 117.30 of Section A of Part 2 of Schedule No. 1, the value thereof shall be the price paid or payable for such goods when sold for home consumption in the ordinary course of trade to any buyers not deemed to be related as specified in section 72 (2) (a), plus any non-rebated excise duty payable in terms of Section B of Part 2 of Schedule No. 1 on such goods."

(2) Subject to the provisions of the Act, this section shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st. June 1991.

3. The Act is amended by substituting for section 111 of the Act the following new section —

“Interest on
outstanding

111. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in any written law —

- (a) interest shall be payable, as from such date and for such period as the Director may determine, on any outstanding amount payable in terms of this Act, other than the outstanding amount of any penalty or forfeiture payable in terms of this Act;
- (b) the interest so payable shall be paid at the rate which the Director may prescribe by rule but which shall not exceed the rate of interest prescribed under the Prescribed Rate of Interest Act;
- (c) the Director may in his discretion and on such conditions as he may consider necessary —
 - (i) remit any interest for which any person is liable by virtue of this section;
 - (ii) permit payment of any amount referred to in paragraph (a) by instalments of such amount and at such times as he may determine;
- (d) any such instalment paid shall be utilized by the Director to discharge any penalty, forfeiture, interest and duty and other amounts due, in that order;
- (e) any such interest shall be calculated monthly, and a portion of a month shall be regarded as a full month; and
- (f) any such interest recovered shall be paid into the Consolidated Revenue Fund.”

An Act to ratify an agreement between the Government and the Government of the Republic of China in respect of a loan for the purpose of promoting economic and technical cooperation between Botswana and the Republic of China.

Date of Assent: 30th April, 1992.

Date of Commencement: 8th May, 1992.

ENACTED by the Parliament of Botswana.

1. This Act may be cited as the Economic and Technical Cooperation Loan (Ratification) Act, 1992. Short title

2. The raising of a loan by the Government from the Government of the Republic of China (hereinafter referred to as "the loan"), subject to such terms and conditions as were agreed between the two Governments, in a sum not exceeding thirty million Renminbi Yuan (or the equivalent at the date hereof of approximately P12 540 000), for the purpose of promoting economic and technical cooperation between Botswana and the Republic of China, is hereby ratified. Ratification of loan

3. The proceeds of the loan ratified by this Act shall be paid into the Development Fund. Loan to be paid into Development Fund

4. All sums required to repay the loan and to pay interest and other charges thereon shall be charged upon and paid out of the Consolidated Fund. Loan to be charged upon Consolidated Fund

5. The signing on behalf of the Government of the agreement embodying the terms and conditions of the loan, and the doing of all such things as may be necessary or expedient to effect or facilitate the loan, are hereby ratified.

“(3) Notwithstanding the provisions of Part II of this Act, regulations made by the Minister may, where for reasons of security, improvement of control over vehicles and their identification, the high incidence of vehicle thefts, or for any other sufficient reason, he considers such a course to be necessary or desirable, provide that vehicles and trailers previously registered under this Act and allocated registration numbers and registration books, should have such registration cancelled, should be required to be re-registered and should be allocated new registration numbers and new registration books, on such terms as he may specify.”.
