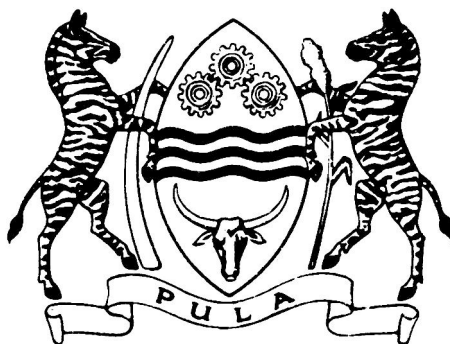

**Prorogation of Parliament**

PROCLAMATION

by

HIS EXCELLENCY SIR KETUMILE MASIRE, P.H., LL.D., J.P., M.P.  
PRESIDENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF BOTSWANA

WHEREAS it is provided by section 91 (1) of the Constitution of Botswana that the President may at any time prorogue Parliament;

NOW THEREFORE in exercise of the powers conferred upon me by the said section 91 (1), I Quett Ketumile Joni Masire, President of the Republic of Botswana, hereby declare, proclaim and make known that Parliament is prorogued today, the 3rd day of November, 1995.

Appointment of Session of Parliament

PROCLAMATION

by

HIS EXCELLENCY SIR KETUMILE MASIRE, P.H., LL.D., J.P., M.P.  
PRESIDENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF BOTSWANA

WHEREAS it is provided by section 90 (1) of the Constitution of Botswana that each session of Parliament shall be held at such place within Botswana and shall commence at such time as the President shall appoint:

NOW THEREFORE in exercise of the powers conferred upon me by the said section 90 (1), I, Quett Ketumile Joni Masire, President of the Republic of Botswana, hereby declare, proclaim and make known that a session of Parliament shall be held at the Parliament House, Gaborone, commencing at 2.30 o'clock in the afternoon of the 6th November, 1995.
