- 2. Amendment of Fourth Schedule to Act No. 28 of 1992

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the Minister of Commerce and Industry by section 16 (2) of the Wildlife Conservation and National Parks Act, the following Order is hereby made—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Controlled Hunting Areas (Amendment) Order, 1995
- 2. The Fourth Schedule to the Wildlife Conservation and National Parks Act is hereby amended by inserting, immediately after the last entry therein, the following new entries —

Amendment of Fourth Schedule to Act No. 28 of 1992

Citation

"22. Controlled Hunting Area NG/40

The area of the Chobe National Park contained within the Ngamiland District as described in the First Schedule of the Wildlife Conservation and National Parks Act, 1992 (Act No. 28 of 1992).

23. Controlled Hunting Area NG/41
